**2.7  
million  
tons of  
plastic  
waste**

The Philippines generates 2.7 million tons of plastic waste annually and 20% - or half a million tons - of that leaks into the oceans.



## EVERYDAY...

About **35,580 tons** of garbage is generated in the Philippines.

About **0.5kg** and **0.3kg** of garbage in the urban and rural areas, respectively.



Almost **48 million shopping bags** are used throughout the Philippines, adding up to more than 17 billion a year.
